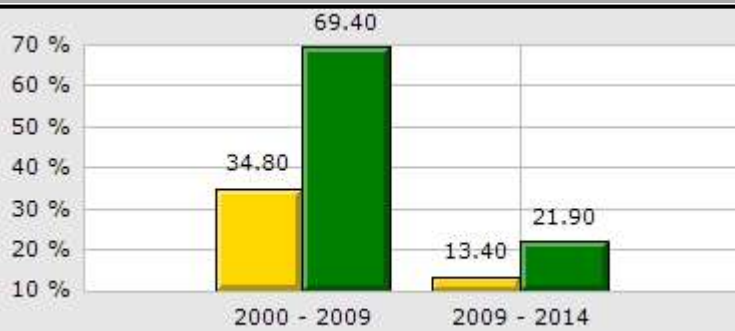

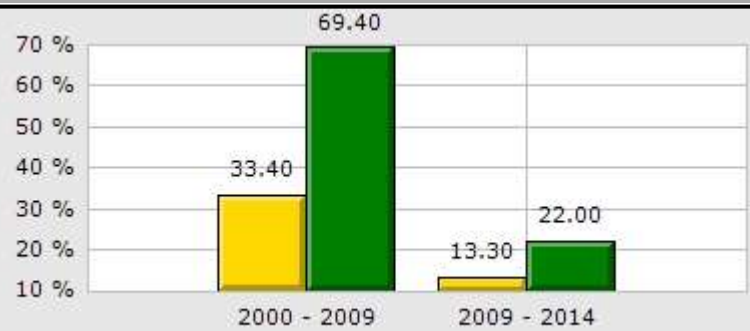

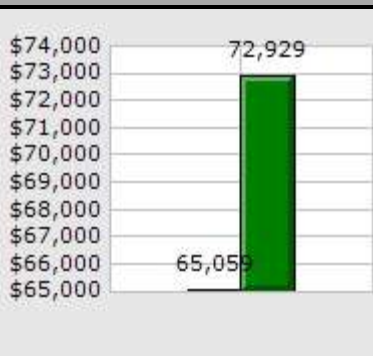
**Population Growth**



**Household Growth**



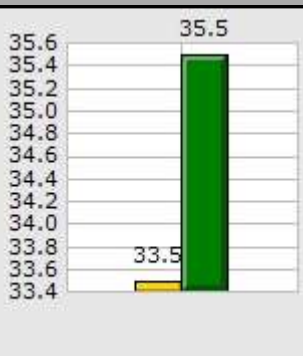

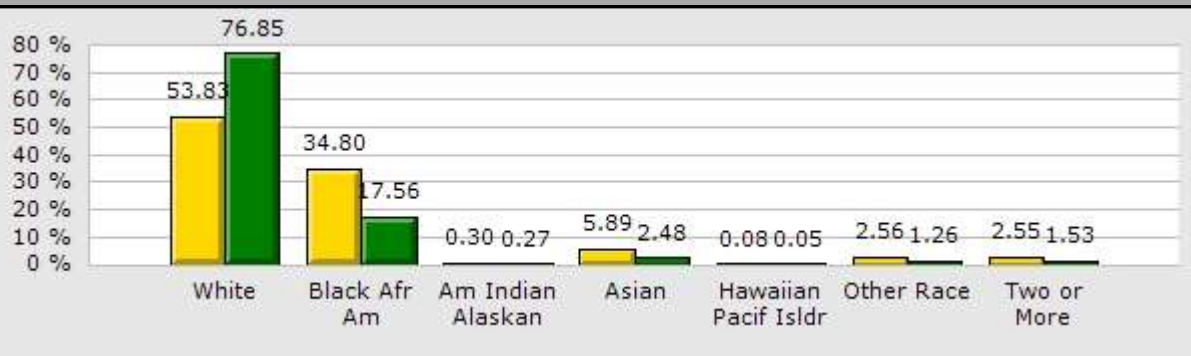
**2009 Households by Household Income**



**2009 Median Age**



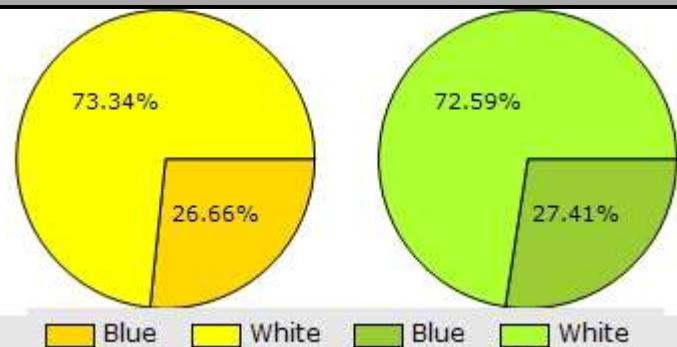
**2009 Population by Race**
